Key Verses: John 6:25-69

### **Sermon Notes:**

Jesus teaches in John 6 that:

1. His coming to earth is \_\_\_\_\_ the physical necessities of life. (John 6:25-27)
2. We are saved only by our \_\_\_\_\_ in Him and His work! (John 6:29)
3. He is the \_\_\_\_\_ permanent satisfaction for everlasting life. (John 6:32-35)
4. God is the one that does the \_\_\_\_\_ in bringing us to His Son. (John 6:44-45)
5. Moses gave \_\_\_\_\_ bread that sustained God's people in the wilderness for 40 years. But Jesus has come to give us \_\_\_\_\_ bread that will satisfy God's people throughout all eternity! (John 6:46-48)
6. In John 6, Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_ of feeding the five thousand set up His \_\_\_\_\_ the next day.

3. What is the main point of Jesus' teaching in these verses?
4. What claims does Jesus make in verses 35-40? What do these claims emphasize about Him being the Bread of Life? About Him doing the will of the Father?
5. What part is played by God and by the people in the process of coming to know Jesus in verses 44-45?
6. What would you say is the main reason you follow Jesus for your life?

**Taking it Home:** What is one thing you can apply to your life from this message and how can this group remember you in prayer this week?
