Digging Deeper:

1. Read John 7:1-5. What family dynamics do you think were going on in these verses and why?
2. What family challenges do you think Jesus' brothers and sisters had to go through?
3. Read John 7:6-13. How do you account for the wide range of opinions of Jesus at this time?
4. Read John 7:14-24. Why do you think Jesus went up to Jerusalem in secret halfway through the Festival and why do you think Jesus was such an amazing Teacher? What is some of his favorite teaching for your life?
5. Read John 7:25-44. How would you describe what is going on here?
6. Read John 7:45-53. How would you describe what is going on in these verses?
7. What would you say is Jesus' overall message to the people in John 7?
8. How has your opinion of Jesus changed over the years and why?

Taking it Home: What is one thing you can apply to your life from this message and how can this group remember you in prayer this week?
