**To raise funds to buy a new motorcycle for our missionary so that he can safely and efficiently continue his work in the rough, rural terrain of the mission field**

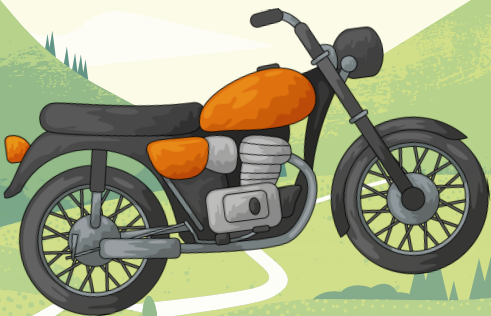
### How You Can Help

**Pray** - Let's pray for our missionary's safety on the road and for the hearts of those they are reaching in these remote villages

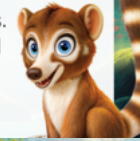
