

Quick Review:

Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything you heard for the first time or that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?

Introduction question for groups:

What was the most important meeting you ever went to and how did it go? Digging Deeper:

- 1. If someone was to ask you what a "calling" is, what would you say?
- 2. In Matthew 28: 16-20, Jesus calls an important "all disciples" meeting after His resurrection. In vs 26, it says that when they saw Him, they worshiped Him but some doubted. What do you think they were doubting? How do you explain this?
- 3. Do you think it is normal for Christians at times to have doubts about their faith in Jesus, why or why not?
- 4. How have you gone about dealing with your doubts in your spiritual journey and what advice would you give to someone today?
- 5. When Jesus gave the Great Commission of Matthew 28:18-20 to His disciples, what do you think was going through their minds? What goes through yours?
- 6. The subject of the Mission in Matthew 28 is "them". Jesus says to make disciples, baptize, & teach "them". How do you define who the "them" is and who is the us?
- 7. When you think about the Great Commission and Jesus' calling for your life, what frightens and excites you the most?
- 8. In what ways can *you* fulfill the Great Commission in the context of your family, work, job, and church?
- 9. The book of Acts is the recording of how the disciples of Jesus took the Great Commission to their world. What do you think are some things we can learn from this book in teaching and encouraging us share Jesus in our lost and broken world today?

Begin reading the book of Acts this week.

MISSIONS HIGHLIGHT

DOUG & KELLEY SAMUELSON - HOPE RENEWED

We are so grateful for you, Pastor Frank and the Woodbridge CC family. Your ministry partnership means the world to us! I'm going to share this update through a list of prayer requests.

We have several requests for prayer and are in great need of prayer.

Our new ministry has launched (November 1st) and God is moving powerfully as we obediently move forward in faith.

Prayer Requests:

- 1. That God would guide us as we launch The Ekklesia Center. This is a training and equipping center whose mission is to disciple, commission and mobilize believers to transform communities, cities, states, and nations. Our vision is to see everyday people empowered as Kingdom influencers in all spheres of society. The launch is in April. Please pray that the right people will hear God's call for them to attend the opening meeting. (More information will be coming in our next newsletter, due in March)
- Prayer for God's continued presence at our regular Praise and Worship nights, group meals, couple meals, prayer, healing, and deliverance meetings. We utilized the home God gave us for these meetings and gatherings. Please also pray for several maintenance projects that must be completed at the ministry center (our home). Resources and skilled laborers.
- Prayer for the individuals and couples we are discipling and mentoring local and abroad (many of which are our spiritual sons and daughters). At this time, prayer specifically for Wes and Jesha, Bruce and Randi, Nicole, Anubhay, Niles, Chris and LuEllen.
- 4. Prayer for the Trafficked Women's and Children's center we have been asked to launch in Biloxi, Mississippi. The state of Mississippi came to us asking that we would utilize a hospital purchased by our group for ministry, to meet the overwhelming need they have for safe places for the women and children the are rescuing. We are currently renovating the 200,000 square foot space that will be used for ministry. Please pray for resources for maintenance and repair, skilled laborers, staff, financial partnerships, and program mentorship (Minnesota Teen Challenge has agreed to come along side and help mentor us as we launch and prepare the staff).
- 5. Prayer for the infrastructure of our new ministry (Hope Renewed). As with any new ministry launch, there are many many pieces that need to be set correctly in place. God has been so good to bring us people and resources to us help with the launch, but there are still needs that remain. Please pray that God will continue to lead us. Please also pray for financial partnerships. God has made it clear to us that He provides for His work. We believe in faith that He will provide, but please pray with us for those storehouses to be opened!
- 6. Lastly, we are excited to share that yesterday morning our son Nate called after having no contact with us in over a year and he said that he has come to believe in the Father. He is in some trouble, and he will be going to a Christian treatment center in Florida but when he gets out he plans to come home to be with Kelley and I for a time. His treatment is scheduled for two weeks.

Would you please pray?

- For his protection in this time (He is still mixed up even as he has discovered the truth)
- 2. For his total deliverance
- 3. For the Lord to prepare our spirits and hearts to receive him.
- 4. For him to come into (finally) the full understanding of the purpose for which God made him.
