

- 6. When you read 1 Corinthians 15:35~58, what is Paul teaching about our new resurrected bodies and when will we get them?
- 7. What do you believe are some of the characteristics of the resurrected body that Christians will receive?
- 8. What do you believe is the sting of death and how did Jesus win the victory over death? How do you share in this victory now? How will you share in this victory in the future?
