

Follow-up Questions from Sunday:

Quick Review:

Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything you heard for the first time or that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?

Introduction question for groups:

What is your favorite flavor of ice cream?

Digging Deeper:

- 1. What do the many different world religions teach about God and what happens to us when we die?
- 2. In Matthew 28:18-19 & Acts 1:8, Jesus told His disciples to go tell the world about what He has done for them. What does Peter teach about Jesus in his sermons found in Acts 2:38; 3:19; 4:12; 5:31; and 10:42?
- 3. Does Paul teach the same message in his sermons found in Acts 13:38-39? How would you describe what the message of the Great Commission is?
- 4. As you read Acts 2; 3:11-26 & 10:42-48, what did Peter do to prove to the people that the message of Jesus was really from God?
- 5. In Acts 13:16~39, what does Paul do to prove that the message of Jesus is really from God?
- 6. In Jesus' parable of the rich man and Lazarus found in Luke 16:19-31, how persuasive does He say that prophecy is in vs 31?
- 7. In the book of Acts, we read what Christianity believes and why they believe it is true (prophecy). What ways can we learn from them to help us be witnesses of Jesus in our world?

Taking it home:

MISSIONS HIGHLIGHT

Pastor Godfrey and Gloria Catanus Iloilo, Philippines

Dear Praying Partners:

We are in the last days and our Enemy, like a roaring lion, seeks whom he may devour and destroy; but PRAISE GOD, greater is He who is in us than he who is in the world!

On April 8, just hours prior to our departure from Iloilo to Chicago, we received an urgent plea for help. A young man who was starting to attend church was struggling against demonic attack. As soon as Pastor Godfrey came into the house, the young man became more physically violent like a trapped animal, mocking at the mention of Jesus Christ and the power of His blood. The young man's eyes looked angry and fierce, his face contorted and his voice growling and threatening.
