Digging Deeper:

1. On Sunday, Millet shared her testimony of how God used WCC to help bring healing to her life. What do you think are the most important ingredients of a healthy church? What do you most look for in a church?
2. When you read Luke 9:23-25 what overall thoughts go through your mind and what do you think are the key words of these verses?
3. How has Jesus' teaching in Luke 9:23-25 impacted your life?
4. If Jesus is the Lord of your heart (1 Peter 3:15), how do you go about giving Jesus the Lordship of your day?
5. Pastor Frank encouraged us to be mindful of Jesus' Presence in the morning (be mindful that He is Lord of all), talk to Him and read the Scriptures. When you wake up each morning what do you do?
6. Each day holds 24 hours, or 1,440 minutes, or 86,400 seconds. What are practical ways we could go about giving Jesus the Lordship over our daily time He gives us to live each day?
7. What does 1 Corinthians 6:19-20 and Romans 12:1 say about the bodies we live in? What are the practical ways we could go about giving Jesus the Lordship over our bodies?
8. Psalm 24:1, Haggai 2:8, and Deuteronomy 8:18 declare that God owns all things and He is the One that gives us the ability to make wealth. What are practical ways we could go about giving Jesus the Lordship over our possessions each day.
9. What does Romans 12:2 say is God's will for our lives? What relationship do you think Luke 9:23-25 and Romans 12:2 have with each other?
