

# MISSIONS HIGHLIGHT

#### Carlos & Edna Ilustre - BCA & Payatas Feeding, Philippines

Prayers for the eight (8) faith communities in Barangay Bagong Silangan, Quezon City that the Lord will raise up more men, women and youth to commit to serve. Coveting prayers for the Lord's guidance as Breakthrough plans to conduct the 2nd Equipping Training during this summer vacation from June to July 2025 with the theme, "Becoming a Church without Walls" (Zecharias 2:1-3). Pray for the training of more teachers for the children (Jesus Fun Club) and youth. Coveting your prayers for the ongoing two classes ongoing as they go through the ISOM (or the International School of Ministry) video bible school training that meet every week to earn their Certificate in Biblical Studies.

Ongoing mentoring and discipleship meeting through the house to house visitation ongoing targeting the menfolks and fathers in the eight (8) faith communities in Barangay Bagong Silangan, Quezon. Praise Report: each of these communities has a core of at least 4 committed fathers that meet every week (weekday evenings in their homes) for the LIFE Groups. LIFE is our small group mentoring and discipleship cover the themes; L for lordship of Christ, I for intercession training by doing, that is praying for others, F for fellowship of believers strengthening each other including sharing their personal learnings in the past week relating the lived experiences with lessons in the bible facilitated by Coaches (functioning as shepherds), and E for evangelism one on one mainly weekly visitation to prospective new "recruits". Conducted weekly training for the Coaches and learning facilitators (or teachers) using the messages preached during the Sunday liturgical celebrations held at the main worship center in the BCA Sanctuary.

We conduct the weekend feeding every Saturday and Sunday. The Sunday feeding usually happens after the congregation worship services, the budget of which comes from the voluntary contributions and offering of the members.

Weekly Saturday Feeding in the Community/Areas only for Children:

Tumana Proper and Clemencia - 75 children

Tumana Dulo - 25 children

Phase 5, Jubilee and Phase 3 - 40 children

Country Homes - 35 children

Total Number of children fed - 205 children

The average cost per meal is PhP 50.00.

Weekly budget for Saturday feeding is PhP 10,250.00.

#### Updates on: Illness of Sis. Edna S. Illustre

Previously, Edna had her total hysterectomy in 2021 after having been diagnosed with endometrial cardinoma stage 1A. For three years, she has been regularly visiting her OB Gyne oncologist.

November 2023 – early symptoms manifested; detected mass on the left and right of Edna's thyroid remain untreated as the priority is the para aortic mass detected in her early PET CT scan with contrast. May 2024 – diagnosis of para aortic mass, Philippine Heart Center, admitted and discharged, undergone two biopsies findings on mass is just a "puss" (negative for growth and malignancy in her para aortic mass); gastroenterologist; pathologist, cardiologist and infectious disease specialists consulted but results were inconclusive.

August 2024 to February 2025 – admitted and discharged repeated due to severe pain at the left where the para aortic mass was detected by the PET CT scan with contrast; laboratory tests and consultations with several internal medicine specialists on various occasions done at the hospital or in their clinics (gastroenterologist, oncologist, urologist, cardiologist, nephrologist, pathologist); after open biopsy and further tests, Edna was diagnosed with endometrial carcinoma stage IVA (recurrence of her cancer about three years ago).

September 21, 2024 to January 21, 2025, Edna went through six cycles of chemotherapy. Currently, Edna was admitted for pain management concerns. She is still confined up to the time of the writing of this narrative report. Her repeated CBC lab tests indicated an erratic movement of her hemoglobin and platelet levels preventing her discharge from the hospital. The oncologist treating Edna referred her case to a hematologist to examine her blood to look into the cause of the problem of the hemoglobin and platelet levels. Coveting your prayers for Edna.
