# ITINERARY

## Day 1 - Saturday - 03/17/2018

Depart USA for Messianic Journey to Israel

The flight to Israel begins your Woodbridge Community: Messianic Journey to Israel. Enjoy the Flight!

## Day 2 - Sunday - 03/18/2018

Modern Tel Aviv

Land in modern Tel Aviv (Biblical Lod/Lydda.) Travel up the Mediterranean coast to the lovely Dan Hotel at Biblical Caesarea.

## Day 3 - Monday - 03/19/2018

Caesarea, Megiddo, Mt. Carmel, Mt. Arbel

Begin the morning at Caesarea, Herod's luxurious port. At this seat of Roman government, Cornelius became the first Gentile to come to faith in Messiah; here the Apostle Paul stood trial for proclaiming the Resurrection of Jesus. In Caesarea's amphitheater sing God's praises where Agrippa failed to give God the glory. On Mount Carmel, remember God's great power where Deborah defeated the Canaanites and Elijah overcame the prophets of Baal. At Megiddo, the ancient guard city of the Jezreel valley, see the future site of the Battle of Armageddon. At Mt. Arbel overlook the Sea of Galilee, Messiah Jesus' core ministry area.

## Day 4 - Tuesday - 03/20/2018

Around the Sea of Galilee: Messiah Jesus' Ministry

Today spend the day around the Sea of Galilee where Jesus the Messiah spent most of His ministry years. Celebrate the Resurrection on the Galilee shore where the Resurrected Lord prepared breakfast for His disciples. Enjoy a delicious, unforgettable St. Peter's Fish lunch. Study the Scriptures in the synagogue in Jesus' home base of Capernaum — the New Testament will spring from the pages of Scriptures to unforgettable spiritual transformation.

## Day 5 - Wednesday - 03/21/2018

Tel Dan, Caesarea Philippi & Golan Heights

The streams of Tel Dan are the source of the Jordan River. Abraham entered the ancient Canaanite city gate here to rescue Lot. Hike around Jeroboam's altar from the early Northern Kingdom. Then worship the Lord Jesus at Caesarea Philippi where Peter declared: "You are the Messiah!" Survey the Golan Heights from Nimrod's Castle to Mt. Bental on Israel's Syrian border. Back on the Sea of Galilee, visit Migdal, town of Mary Magdalene with its New Testament synagogue, probably visited by Messiah Jesus.

## Day 6 - Thursday - 03/22/2018

Galilee: Nazareth, Sephoris & Mt. Tabor

See Sephoris, the Roman city with its famous mosaics near Jesus little home town of Nazareth. Experience life from the time of Jesus and enjoy lunch in Nazareth Village. Consider the amazing events of the transfiguration on Mt. Tabor. "Sail" the waters of Sea of Galilee for an evening of worship of the Lord Jesus.

## Day 7 - Friday - 03/23/2018

Jordan Valley: Gideon's Spring to the Dead Sea

Trek Beit Shean, the extensively excavated Roman city, important city in the life of King Saul, and later the capital of New Testament Decapolis. Dip your hand in the springs of Ein Harod, where Gideon selected his 300 warriors. At Ein Gedi, the largest oasis on the Dead Sea, be refreshed at the beautiful waterfalls, where David hid from Saul.

## Day 8 - Saturday - 03/24/2018

Shabbat Shalom: Rest at the Dead Sea

Enjoy a day of rest, refreshment and relaxation at your Dead Sea hotel. Shabbat Shalom!

## Day 9 - Sunday - 03/25/2018

Judean Wilderness: Masada & Ein Gedi

At Qumran, see where the Dead Sea Scrolls were produced and preserved demonstrating the reliability of God's Word. Cable car up Masada, the Dead Sea palace of Herod, where the Jewish resistance made their fated last stand against Rome, after the fall of Jerusalem, AD 73. Travel back to the days of the Patriarchs to enjoy a camel ride in the Judean Wilderness and a meal in Abraham's Tent. Up to Jerusalem!

## Day 10 - Monday - 03/26/2018

Jerusalem: Palm Sunday Experience

This Jerusalem day focus on the events of Palm Sunday. Walk down the Mount of Olives on the Palm Sunday Road; overlook Jerusalem where the Lord Jesus wept at Dominus Flavit; and pray in Garden of Gethsemane. See Herodium, Herod the Great's Judean Fortress and the place of his burial.

## Day 11 - Tuesday - 03/27/2018

Jerusalem: King Messiah & King David

Begin the day in the Jewish Quarter of the Old City in worship at the Southern Steps of the Temple. Pray at the Western Wall, then explore the Jewish Quarter. Walk below ground level along the Western Wall to bedrock of this ancient structure chosen by the LORD for His people to worship. Explore the beginning of Jewish Jerusalem in the City of David, and splash through Hezekiah's Tunnel to the Pool of Siloam.

## Day 12 - Wednesday - 03/28/2018

Jerusalem: Christian Quarter & Passion of Messiah Jesus

Our final day in Jerusalem day focuses on understanding more fully the Atonement of our Messiah Jesus. Stand in the archaeology of Caiphas House, were the Lord Jesus stood trial. Walk atop the Temple Mount, for a sense of the grandeur of the New Testament Temple. See the Pools of Bethesda, the Upper Pool of Jerusalem, where Isaiah confronted Ahaz; and were Messiah Jesus healed the lame man. Walk the Way of the Cross to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. The day culminates in a celebration of the Resurrection of Messiah Jesus at the Garden Tomb. Enjoy a Farewell Dinner together at our hotel, and get ready for an early morning departure home.

Shalom Israel! Hello USA!

Shalom to Israel and Hello to USA! Early morning flights back home with time to process all you've learned and experienced on this Messianic Journey.



Join Pastor Frank Winans of Woodbridge Community Church, Irvine, California, and Pastor Aaron Young of Rising Church in Atlanta, for a trip of a life time to the Land of Israel. This will be an amazing time learning the Scriptures on location. You will explore your spiritual heritage, deepen your walk with the Lord Jesus, and have a wonderful time!

FLIGHT-Round-trip from Los Angeles or Atlanta to Tel Aviv  
LODGING - 4-Star Israeli hotels (double occupancy = 2 people per room, each person pays \$4250.00)  
SINGLE ROOM - If do not want a roommate, the additional cost of a single room is \$995.00. If you want a roommate, but do not have a roommate, we will try to place you with another single traveler of the same gender. However, if no one is available to room with you, you will be charged for a single room. If you are traveling with (or have been assigned) a roommate who cancels, you will be responsible for a single room if no one else is available to be your roommate.

MEALS - breakfast and dinner daily with coffee, tea.

TOURING - per itinerary (subject to adjustment) with licensed Israeli Tour Guide in private air-conditioned tour bus with Israeli driver

ALL TIPS and FEES (for tour guide, driver, porters, dining & hotel staff), taxes, entrance fees, transportation costs. The price of this trip is ALL inclusive - it includes everything (except lunches)

## **Price Does Not include:**

Lunches, beverages (other than coffee and tea), personal expenses (snacks, phone, laundry, internet), travel/trip insurance.

## **Refunds/Cancellations:**

All cancellation notices must be received in writing (e-mail) to the Messianic Journeys office. Refunds for cancellation are based on the time of the cancellation

Until August 31, 2017: Trip Registration Deposit is refundable less \$300.00 cancellation fee.

September 2 -October 31, 2017 : Refund less \$1000 cancellation fee.

One piece of checked luggage, maximum 50 pounds. Plus, one small personal bag (small enough to comfortably fit on your lap on the tour bus). Luggage is limited due to the tour bus luggage bay capacity.
